Watertown Community Education is pleased to announce that we are accepting registrations for our **February Vacation Program entitled Kids' Planet** for children Grades PreK-5. The Program will run Tuesday through Friday, February 22-February 25, 2011 at the Hosmer School. Please use the Concord Road entrance for drop off and pick up. The hours are 8:30AM-5:30PM. The cost of the program is \$220 for the week. Full tuition payment must accompany your registration to assure a space for your child. All registrations must be received by Friday, February 11th.

Did you know that kids and their families can make a big difference in making the earth a healthy place for animals? Did you know that there are about 500 animals in the world that are endangered because where they live is no longer safe for them? The list of endangered animals includes the giant panda, bald eagles, American alligators, gorillas, grizzly bears, black rhinos, tigers, lots of whales and turtles, and some types of fish. Find out what kids and their families can do to make the environment a healthier place for animals and for people. Included in our fun and fact-packed week, we'll have a visit from Rainforest Reptiles and the Nature Conservancy (an organization that protects the Earth's most important natural places). We will visit lots of websites like the Kids' Planet, National Geographic, the World Wildlife Federation, Scholastic News and the San Diego Zoo to learn other facts about the endangered animals around the world and think of ways we can help them.

If you would like your child to join the fun please sign up early. Enrollments are limited and on a first-come, first-served basis. Watertown Community Education reserves the right to cancel the Program if under-enrolled. If severe weather prevents the program from operating, families will be called as soon as possible. Your child may attend for the entire week or split the week with another family. If you wish to split the week, this arrangement should be done by families and is not the responsibility of Watertown Community Education. A medical emergency form must be completed and allergies and/or medical conditions must be disclosed before your child can attend. Please note that the administering of any medications is the sole responsibility of the parent/guardian and appropriate arrangements should be made.
