Watertown Community Education is pleased to announce that we are accepting registrations for our February Vacation Program entitled *Ready! Set! Sew!* for children Grades PreK-5. The Program will run Tuesday through Friday, February 21-February 24, 2012 at the Hosmer School. Please use the Concord Road entrance for drop off and pick up. The hours are 8:30AM-5:30PM. The cost of the program is \$250 for the week (\$62.50/day). Full tuition payment must accompany your registration to assure a space for your child. All registrations must be received by Friday, February 10th.

The **Ready! Set! Sew!** will be a whole week of fun projects including pencil cases and backpacks to carry your stuff! Other projects will include hats, tie-dyed shirts, aprons, friendship bracelets and even wallets made out of duct tape. Of course, students will also be learning a basic life skill that is creative and useful-sewing. When kids make something themselves, they know for certain that it is one of a kind. Being able to sew on a button or repair a small rip is something everyone should know how to do. Kids will also learn patience, how to follow directions and the satisfaction of completing a project. At the end of our week, we will have an exhibit and fashion show to show off our fabulous sewing projects. **Please send your child with a plain white tee shirt for our tie dying activity. If you can also send an old pillowcase or an old pair of jeans, we have projects that will recycle these articles.**

If you would like your child to join the fun please sign up early. Enrollments are limited and on a first-come, first-served basis. Watertown Community Education reserves the right to cancel the Program if under-enrolled. If severe weather prevents the program from operating, families will be called as soon as possible. Your child may attend for the entire week or split the week with another family. If you wish to split the week, this arrangement should be done by families and is not the responsibility of Watertown Community Education. A medical emergency form must be completed and allergies and/or medical conditions must be disclosed before your child can attend. Please note that the administering of any medications is the sole responsibility of the parent/guardian and appropriate arrangements should be made.
